Comfortable accommodation

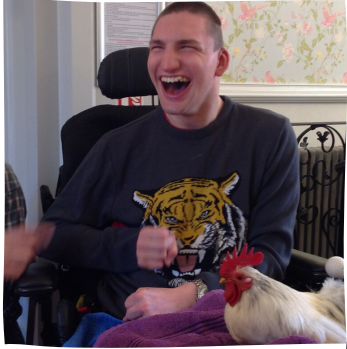
Strode Park House combines all the magic of a period property with contemporary 'award winning' accommodation in the form of the ReAbility Wing.
